



Understanding the Metadata

ACAPS Yemen Analysis Hub developed this product to better understand what is the analysis and data collection landscape in Yemen. Namely, we tried to map out who are the main stakeholders in data collection and analysis in Yemen, what are the main kinds of primary datasets, assessment reports, and analysis reports produced on the Yemen crisis, what is their focus (topic, sector, population groups), when are they published and how often, and who is their targeted audience.

Between January and beginning of March 2019 ACAPS reviewed over 130 analysis products and primary datasets publicly available (published or shared publicly), issued between 2015 and 2019, focused on or useful for understanding the Yemen humanitarian crisis. The 130 products include data or analysis produced by humanitarian and development INGOs and NGOs, the UN, UN agencies, the Yemeni government, governmental agencies, the EU, researchers, think tanks, and the media (humanitarian journalism).

This Metadata was compiled exclusively as first mapping so it might not include latest publications on Yemen or all of the actors involved in reporting on the Yemen crisis.

ACAPS published this metadata for use by other analysis organisations, researchers or think tanks interested in Yemen humanitarian crisis, in analysis or analysis capacity building in Yemen.
